The State Board of Education is made up of 19 members—11 elected and eight appointed by the governor. The chairs of the education committees of the Ohio House and Ohio Senate serve as non-voting ex officio members of the State Board. The statutory duties and responsibilities of the State Board are enumerated in Section 3301.111 of the Ohio Revised Code.
